Why volunteer?

Opportunities...

1. Client-related skills

a. Outreach Services

When: No set times - approx 2-10 hours per week depending upon availability

Where: Anywhere in Queensland

What does it involve: Providing assessment, support and referral to people seeking treatment for an alcohol and/or drug issue

Who should apply: People with the ability to work with people of all ages - must have a blue card (this can be applied for through Teen Challenge).

b. Residential Services

When: Times negotiable (day and evening shifts available)

Where: Either New Life Centre (Toowoomba) or Hebron House (Kelvin Grove, Brisbane)

What does it involve: assisting caseworkers with supervision, activities (e.g. music, sports, work duties, cooking) and transportation

Who should apply: People with the ability to work with young people - must have a blue card (this can be applied for through Teen Challenge).

2. Intercessors heart

When: At your discretion

Where: In your own home

What does it involve: Praying for Teen Challenge including issues included on monthly newsletter (confidentiality applies)

Who should apply: People with a heart for intercession.

3. Reception skills

When: 2-5pm Monday to Friday (availability for all days not necessary)

Where: Mount Gravatt, Brisbane

What does it involve: Answering phones, mail out, banking, cleaning

Who should apply: People with sound English language skills and a heart to serve.

4. Computer skills

When: Times negotiable

Where: Mt Gravatt, Brisbane (or potentially in your own home)

What does it involve: a) Using Macromedia Flash to create pictures for our training program and/or b) Using Microsoft Access to assist with an upgrade of our database

Who should apply: People with skills using the above mentioned computer programs.

5. Policy documentation skills

When: Times negotiable

Where: Mt Gravatt, Brisbane

What does it involve: Documenting policies and procedures regarding Human Resource Management and corporate governance

Who should apply: People with experience in the above mentioned areas.
